There will be 5 awards in the following categories: -

SVQ LEVEL 2 MODERN APPRENTICE OF THE YEAR (Prize = £100)

Nominated by the Assessors and based on achievement of SVQ level 2 Modern Apprentice qualification.

SVQ LEVEL 3 MODERN APPRENTICE OF THE YEAR (Prize = £100)

Nominated by the Assessors and based on achievement of SVQ level 3 Modern Apprentice qualification

Note: The top 3 nominations in both Modern Apprentice categories above will be subject to a visit by the judges at their workplace. These 2 categories are judged by people independent of Scottish Meat Training (SMT) but with sufficient knowledge of the SVQ/MA requirements.

TRAINING MENTOR OF THE YEAR - IN HOUSE (Prize = £100)

This category should be nominated by trainee and should be for the individual who has encouraged the trainee in their development within their workplace.

The prize in this category will be split between the winner and the person nominating them (or the best nomination where more than one has been received for the same person).

This category will be judged by all SMT staff

TRAINING PARTNER OF THE YEAR (Prize = £100)

This category will be for the Employer/Business who has engaged with Scottish Meat Training and the Assessors to maximise the potential of their trainees.

Nomination for this category will be from SMT Assessors.

This category will be judged by all SMT staff.

EXTRA MILE AWARD (Prize = £100)

This category is for the trainee who has “gone the extra mile” in their own progression, new product development, customer service which has had a positive impact on the business they work in.

This category can be nominated by the employer, mentor or customers and will be judged by all SMT staff

The prize in this category will be split between the winner and the best nomination.

Note: The prize for the best nomination will be a £50 voucher for the winner’s workplace. SMT will arrange payment of this voucher to the business as appropriate.
